**RENEWAL AMENDMENT TO

THIS RENEWAL AMENDMENT (“Renewal Amendment”) is made and entered into by and between the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University, located in DeKalb, Illinois, 60115 USA (“NIU”), functioning through its Division of International Affairs, and Thammasat University, located in Bangkok, Thailand (“TU”), functioning through its College of Interdisciplinary Studies.

**WHEREAS**, NIU and TU have entered into that certain Memorandum of Understanding dated July 1, 2019 (the “Agreement”);

**WHEREAS**, the parties now desire to modify and extend the Agreement to the extent set forth below; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. The Agreement shall be extended for an additional three-year term, beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2025, pursuant to Section 7 of the Agreement.


2. For purposes of this Renewal Amendment, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Agreement. The terms set forth above are deemed to be incorporated in and made a part of the Agreement. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall continue unmodified and remain in full force and effect.

### **FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

This First Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement ("**First Amendment**") is made and entered into by and between Thammasat University with a business address of 2 Phra Chan Alley, Khwaeng Phra Borom Maha Ratchawang, Khet Phra Nakhon, Bangkok 10200, Thailand, ("**TU**") and the Board of Trustees of Northern Illinois University, located in DeKalb, Illinois 60115, USA ("**NIU**").

**WHEREAS**, TU and NIU have entered into that certain Memorandum of Agreement dated July 1, 2019 (the "**Agreement**");

**WHEREAS**, the parties now desire to amend and make certain modifications to the Agreement to the extent set forth below; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. In Section 5, Term and Termination of the Agreement, "July 10, 2022" shall be deleted and replaced with "July 10, 2025".

2. The last two lines of Section 10.C. shall be deleted and replaced with the following: "institution, failure or delay in delivery by suppliers or delays in transportation, or pandemic, epidemic or other public health emergency."

3. In Exhibit A, Course List – Transfer Guide, the references to "Articulation Agreement" shall be deleted and replaced with "Memorandum of Agreement".

4. For purposes of this First Amendment, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Agreement. The terms set forth above are deemed to be incorporated in and made a part of the Agreement. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall continue unmodified and remain in full force and effect.


