- 3. A proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, or TU-GET) is preferable.

- 4. Part of a thesis must be published **either** in a journal classified by the Thai-Journal Citation Index Center (TCI) as "TCI 1" or "TCI 2", **or** in any peer-reviewed international publication.
